TREASURERS REPORT	Jason tabled Treasurers Report for the month of June to be returned to Clubs. Term deposit is about to be re-invested at approx. 5%. Exit fee for re investment is confirmed at \$31.00. Mark Jeffery asked whether we could also invest part of our working capital, possibly 300,000.00. It was explained that this was not feasible as we never know what unexpected expenses we may encounter. Dave thought it may be able to work out a viable amount that we may be able to put in a separate Term Deposit, this avenue will be explored and the possibility to be reported to membership.
GENERAL BUSINESS	As per previously reported the tyres that were possibly in need of replacing, did need replacing. The roller shutter had been fixed, however has re broken just before use. Will be fixed on Wednesday. Dave reported that the liberation site for Ballimore was in a boggy condition after 52mm of rain in 4 days. A preferable site has been located at Dubbo. Schedule to be adjusted accordingly. All agreed.



	Discussion ensued regarding catching up the missed weekends racing. 2 Suggestions 1. 2 Dubbo races on the one day with a 12 bird limit. Moved SH 2nd. MBRA 2. Double race on the All Age Derby from Bourke Moved RHD 2nd BLK. 9 votes in favour of option 2 (2 races from Bourke on the one day) Option passed, limits to be finalised
	Surplus tossing was discussed regarding tossing from Mudgee instead of Dubbo, with Shane Brown to travel with the surplus, it was decided to continue to Dubbo at this stage. It was discussed that bringing birds closer to home in inclement weather, to facilitate getting a race in. The consensus from the delegates was that this acceptable as long as it was within protocol. Dave questioned the need for fans to be used in the transporter during cold conditions. it was decided that readings from the truck were required. Milad SH questioned the timing of Liberation information on the Fed Line. Suggested 3.30pm on a Thursday would be a better option.
Business from Clubs	MTD Could we possibly source a different supplier for Life Rings due to the fading and deterioration of the recent rings. Steve Shears suggested that we could source our rings from thiFCI , however all rings would be the same colour. To investigate! BLK Blue rings for next years race are available for next years race. Race to be stand alone ,but held from the same route CCF are flying from. LIV Re; text messages, Adam Archer has yet to speak to anyone regards the SMS service, however something was possibly happening with Brian Becker KPS. WV There have been several enquiries re plastic basket inserts. WV remind that the cost is APPROX \$78 Per set.

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	Comments were made regarding the condition of the surplus birds, apparently the whirly birds on the surplus truck are non functional. It was reported that the surplus birds were tracked coming via Taree. It was also reported that the water tank on the small truck had a broken bracket. This to be repaired by next weeks race. There was discussion regarding some Clubs not wanting to fly the North Route.
