MEETING OPENED	8.02pm
PRESENT	Delegates as per attendance register
APOLOGIES	Nil
PREVIOUS MINUTES	Accepted 1 st Dural 2 nd SMPS
BUSINESS ARISING	Dave Gordon confirmed that Thursday Night basketing from Nevertire was not moved by himself , but was actually moved from the floor. It was mentioned that the exhaust on the toss truck situation needs to be addressed as a matter of urgency prior to future surplus tossing. Steve stated that the sensors that had been purchased needed to be implemented, and care should be taken to monitor exhaust effects.

These are not ready as yet. SMPS questioned whether birds were given water at Fairfield Showground. This happens if enough people are available to do the work. A Huge Thank You was given from the chair to Ryan Coy for all his work regarding the plumbing on the trucks, ensuring all our birds are given access to sufficient water. There was also a round of applause given to the Liberation Committee for all their work over the previous weekend. KPS Robert Gates called for the need for future planning over the next season with a lot of flyers not planning to fly the North Route. This may cause a large rise in costs. Dave Gordon pointed out that we would only need to use 1 truck which would reduce costs. Dave also advised That a survey would be sent to Clubs around Young Bird Derby Time re prospective numbers. GREY advised they would not be racing. WV advised the passing of CCF flyer Kevin Blande . A minutes silence was held in respect. WV also asked if the CCF Public Liability Insurance covered individual Clubs. It was advised that it does not.
